

Uniform/Dress Code Policy

Uniforms are an important part of the way we remain connected as a school community. When wearing the St. Barnabas School uniform, inside and outside the school, students represent the school and their behavior should be a credit to themselves, their families, and the school community. We ask that all parents and students adhere to the uniform policy outlined below to help our school community retain this important part of our identity.

A student who wears a visible item that is not specifically permitted by the dress code is in violation of the code. Students violating the dress code will be first sent home with a dress code violation including an explanation. If the item violating the dress code is worn again without parental communication with a teacher, a demerit may be issued. The administration of St. Barnabas School has the ultimate authority to determine the appropriateness of all attire, including special dress days.

The PTU sponsors Uniform Exchange events throughout the school year, where new and gently used uniform items are available for a small fee charged through FACTS. You do not need to bring an item to purchase an item. The Uniform Exchange chairperson may also be able to accommodate a special request, outside of the scheduled sessions by appointment, please contact <u>PTU@barnabasohio.org</u>.

Purchasing Uniforms

St. Barnabas School has contracted with two uniform vendors to provide our families a variety of options. St. Barnabas recommends that you purchase your items from the uniform vendors listed below, as all items in these school shops are approved for use at the school.

Most of the products from Prime Time Sporting Goods (<u>stbarnabas.itemorder.com</u>) are considered spirit wear and are **not** permitted per the standard and dress uniforms, but one item, the Jerzees Nublend ¼-Zip Cadet Collar Sweatshirt is permitted. It is available in youth and adult sizes. School logo must be selected.

Note that items purchased from other vendors must mirror the style and color options offered from School Belles and Lands' End. If you purchase items from other vendors, embroidery services are available for a fee from the following:

GIRLS K-8	 Hairstyles: neatly trimmed and not hanging in front of face. Makeup and perfume are not permitted. Nail polish is permitted A single pastel color is allowable No artificial nails or tips Simple jewelry that complements the uniform may be worn. No more than two pairs of small stud earrings per ear No more than two bracelets No more than one necklace 	
BOYS K-8	 Hairstyles: neatly trimmed and not hanging in front of the face. Must be above the shirt collar, the top of the ear and the eyebrow. Cologne is not permitted. Facial hair: it is expected that boys be clean-shaven. Beards, mustaches, and sideburns extending below the earlobe or onto the cheek are not permitted. Nail polish is not permitted Simple jewelry that complements the uniform may be worn. No more than two bracelets No more than one necklace 	
NOT PERMITTED	 Not permitted: inappropriate hairstyles, extreme spiking, unnatural colors or combinations of colors of hair, scarves, bandanas, hats or other headwear, anatomical piercing, except for the ear (girls only) or tattoos either temporary or permanent. Headwear worn as a legitimate religious attire (as determined by the School Principal) may be considered an exception. No accessory may be worn that is contrary to the philosophy of the school. 	



SPECIAL DRESS DAYS			
DRESS DOWN DAYS	 Permitted: jeans, sweatpants, athletic pants, yoga pants, leggings provided the shirt touches the fingertips when arms are down at the sides, shorts (during 1st and 4th quarters), T-shirts, polo shirts or sweatshirts Not permitted: ripped, torn, tight-fitting or painted clothing, clothing with inappropriate words, hats or headwear, armbands, crop tops, tank tops, tube tops, halter tops, low-rise pants, and shorts (during 2nd and 3rd quarters). While the school may have a special dress day, a class that has Liturgy or special activities may be directed by their teacher to adhere to the <i>Standard and Dress Uniforms</i>. Students dressed inappropriately on a dress down day will be issued a demerit, and may be kept out of class until appropriate clothing is found or brought from home. If a student continues to violate the dress code he/she may lose future "out of uniform" privileges. 		
DRESS UP DAYS	 An example of a Dress Up Day would be Picture Day, Awards Day, Concerts, etc. Follow the guidelines outlined from the Principal. Students are not required to wear <i>Standard and Dress Uniforms</i>. Athletic shoes, athletic shorts, t-shirts, jeans, tank tops, spaghetti straps are examples of items that are not permitted. 		
BIRTHDAY	• Students may dress down on the day of his/her birthday is celebrated. Please consult with your teacher prior to dressing down.
